August 2022 Captain's Report

Acquisitions -

Old News: We formalized the purchase of two new 4X/- and two new 2X's from Hudson. They are smaller hulls (light and light-mid) We are expecting delivery any time between 1-3 months from now

New News – the Rowing Committee is recommending purchase of a lightly used Hudson 2X/that is mid/heavy. Its purchase is consistent with our acquisitions, in our 5-year plan, and a better price than budgeted. The boat is owned by Jonathan Haisman. It's 2018 hull, full reburb in 2022 and has very low mileage. Includes sweep and sculling riggers, cover, sweep oars, slings and tools. Price is \$14K. (New is \$22K w/o sweep oars) Rowing Committee unanimously approve.

Dispositions – We have sold 5 older Van Dusen 1X's and continue to strategically move hulls no longer being used to make room for new acquisitions. As 2X and 4X hulls are very popular and useful in teaching sculling we have not currently been marketing those, but that will continue to re-examined this as new hulls arrive and space constraints/boat usage is evaluated.

Boat Repairs – The Explorers, KL and Zephyrs have been repaired as has the Watne 4X. All are back at NBC except the Zephyrs – those are still at RowAmerica and need a ride to PVD. Working on logistics, but seeking drivers who might be travelling that way – both can be carried on a standard roof rack. Those are George Nightingale & Sullivan Dorr. Additionally the Wise and Prichett are off-site at Van Dusen having the rigger mounting blocks repaired/replaced.

Private Racks – Members continue to purchase boats with the expectation that they can be stored at NBC. We are doing what we can to accommodate folks, but members should be aware that space is limited, NBC has first rights to boat racks, and we have 4 new boats on order. Please understand that lightly used boats may be asked to be removed from the boathouse.

4X Bow rating – Jonathan Haisman will be leading Sunday AM sessions for folks interested in obtaining a bow rating. Further details will be posted to Google groups.

Cox Rating – Congratulations to Emma Powers who is the first A rated cox under our new cox rating requirements. She can take out a sweep boats without launch presence. Others are in the works.

Sculler Rating - Congratulations to Michael Kidwell who has obtained an "A" sculler rating

Self-Rescue training – Eric & Jonathan will reprise their on-water self-rescue training later this summer. We continue to evaluate our safety rules regarding on water rowing, and the ability to re-enter a flipped shell will always be an important skill.

Low Light Conditions – NBC members are reminded that lights are required when rowing earlier than 30 minutes before sunrise, or 30 minutes after sunset. Currently those times are and 5:46AM and 7:55PM respectively. It's coming! And items of hi-viz clothing are recommended at all times.

Keyless Entry proposal – I have a proposal from a company to provide keyless entry for NBC. I'll provide details at the meeting. The cost is about \$7K which includes about 250 key fobs, although those are not necessary as cell phones also work and would save \$1500.
